# EUROPE PRAYER BREAKFAST (EPB)

Over the last 20 years, PEF has been represented at the EPB, held every year in Brussels, Belgium, inside the European Parliament, linking followers of Jesus from around the European Union in friendship and prayer. Last December 2nd, 550 participants from across Europe and beyond, came together around the theme of "Wisdom from Above" (James 3.17), so much needed in our world! The main speakers were Hans-Adam II, Prince of Liechtenstein, and Sari Essayah, Finland's Minister of Agriculture and Forestry. PEF was represented by Marco Hofmann (Switzerland) and Daniel Costanza (Belgium)

The following day, the **Ukrainian Prayer Breakfast in the European Parliament** (December 3rd) took place, with speakers from Ukraine, Europe and USA. MPs, civil activists, pastors, chaplains, and dozens of participants, including Yuriy Kulakevuch and Daniel Costanza, joined for a time of encouragement, support, blessing and prayer for Ukraine.
